Caring for your watch

Our watches are products of timeless beauty and state-of-the-art manufacturing quality. If a Carl F. Bucherer watch is to be handed down from generation to generation, it should be carefully and regularly maintained.

Cleaning

Use a microfiber cloth to clean the surface and polish it gently. You can clean the case and metal strap with a fine toothbrush and a little soapy water and dry it with a fluff-free towel. Leather is a natural product that ages. Contact with water accelerates this process. Leather straps should therefore come into contact with water as little as possible.

Maintenance

A watch is a mechanical instrument that requires regular maintenance. This includes taking the movement apart, checking the movement components for wear and tear, cleaning and assembly, including oiling and lubricating the movement plus cleaning the case and metal strap. To ensure that the watch continues to function well it is important to have this maintenance carried out by an authorized repair service at regular intervals of approx. every four years.

Water-resistance

We recommend having each Carl F. Bucherer watch checked at least once a year for water resistance. If you see any moisture on the inside of the crystal, please take your watch to an authorized repair service without delay.
